Read the following text below:

⁷So Jesus again said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. ⁸All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. ⁹I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. ¹⁰The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. ¹¹ I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (John 10:7-10, ESV)

- Is Jesus your Good Shepherd?
- If He is, what does it mean for you and your life to belong to Him as one of His sheep?

Slowly read Psalm 23 below, pausing after each verse, first praying and asking the Holy Spirit to speak to you through the words.
